## **SCHOLARSHIP NEWS**

The 2022/2023 school year has started, which means that the Elks National Foundation scholarship season has started.


The Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship is available online starting August 1, 2022 and is available online at <u>enf.elks.org/MVS</u>. The Deadline is on or before November 14, 2022. The judging at Lodge level is from December 2-19, 2022 with District judging Dec 28, 2022 until Jan 11 2023. From District the winners are sent to State Judging which is February 2-21, 2023. The winners at that level are forwarded to Elks National Foundation for final judging. There are 500 four year awards: Two \$50,000 scholarships; two \$40,000 Scholarships; two \$30,000 Scholarships; 14 \$20,000 scholarships; and 480 \$4,000 scholarships, all paid over a four year period.

The Legacy Awards is for the children and grandchildren of Elks members. The eligibility is a college bound high school seniors who are the children and grandchildren of dues-paying Elks. Visit enf.elks.org/leg for full eligibility details. The judging criteria: Applications are evaluated based on their commitment of the core values of the ENF: Knowledge; Charity; Community Service; and Integrity. Legacy scholars are required to serve with the Elks throughout college to receive their scholarship funds. Visit enf.elks.org/LegVolunteer to learn more. Applications are available online starting September 1, 2022 at enf.elks.org/leg and the deadline is on or before February 6, 2023.

#### STUDENT OF THE MONTH

The Student of the Month program starts with September and goes through May with Student of the Year being selected from the nine male and female seniors and presented to the winners at Senior Class Awards Night at their high school. Over the past years that I have been the scholarship chairman, I have met many outstanding young people who have done great things after completing college. The high school counselors and school administrators select the male and female student. The selection is based on grades, leadership, school activities and awards, and community service. We wish all the students a great school year.





# Volusia Regional Community Charities, Inc.

### YOUR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE PORT ORANGE ELKS CAN NOW BE TAX DEDUCTIBLE

As many of you are aware, donations made to the Port Orange Elks (for the benefit of the many community causes the Elks support), historically have not been tax deductible because we are not designated 501 (c) 3 according to IRS regulations. The Elks are a 501(c) 8 Fraternal Organization. This provides our Lodge a not-for-profit status, but donations from the community or our members directly to the Elks are not tax deductible. We have struggled for many years with how we can remedy that situation. We have recently established a relationship with a new organization, namely Volusia Regional Community Charities, Inc. also known as VRCCI.

There are also isolated situations where a tax deductible fund raising effort is appropriate, such as supporting a specific family of a fallen Police Officer or Firefighter. We can rapidly without a lot of red tape create a pass thru fund to help that specific situation – and team up with the other fraternal organizations throughout the community to improve the effectiveness securing donations.

In order to make a tax deductible donation you must simply designate on your check (made payable to VRCCI) indicating in the memo section of the check that it is to benefit the Port Orange Elks #2723. Mail your check to 1648 Taylor Road, Port Orange, FL 32128 VRCCI will see that your intentions are met. VRCCI will also provide at a later date a receipt acknowledging your tax deductible donation. That receipt will indicate the required information regarding your tax deductible donation.


